The service edits your manuscript before you submit for publication to enhance its chances of being accepted.

We can help improve your manuscript's

- grammar and spelling,
- punctuation and capitalization,
- documentation style,
- clarity of expression, and
- organization and logic.

As requested, we can also help with substantive edits, proofreading, and many other services.

Our service is FREE for faculty and staff in the following units:

- Humanities,
- Family, Home, and Social Sciences,
- Marriott School, and
- Harold B. Lee Library.

These units pay an annual subsidy for their faculty and staff to use our service.

Other faculty may pay a modest fee of \$27.50 per hour.



We generally accept projects on a first-come, first-served basis, though we will make every effort to accommodate your schedule. Our turnaround time depends on the current project load; ideally, plan on two weeks for an article and two months for a book manuscript.

Our editing speed generally ranges between 1250 to 2000 words per hour. The exact rate will vary based on the complexity of editing required.
